CDA Overview:

Candidates will acquire professional development training in eight subject areas required by the Council for Professional Recognition to earn a National CDA. Candidates will network with other aspiring CDA Candidates while building their skill set in areas from “ Planning a Safe, Healthy ,Learning Environment to “Understanding the Principles of Child Development”. Candidates will build a Professional Portfolio by developing impressive “Reflective Competency Statements” and collecting “Resource Items” for six competency areas.
